Description	<p>The theme of this IP is the transition from informal learning outside school into more formal learning in the school system in early education. The objectives are 1. To investigate and develop new knowledge of the learning of small children and develop new inclusive strategies of teaching in a European perspective. 2. To develop new strategies of collaboration between professionals around the target group and give students experience herein.</p> <p>The target group is children between the ages of 4 and 7 and the focus is on the different ways of learning of this group of children which could be called informal learning processes and on the problems experienced in the different countries engaging small children in an inclusive learning environment. Main activities will be lectures, workshops, fieldtrips, cross national group work, presentations, teaching in schools and kindergartens, evaluation and dissemination of results. Students are expected to learn new approaches to work with the target group, competences in working together with other professionals, international and intercultural competences. The IP is expected to give new inspiration and knowledge to professionals about teaching and methods in a European perspective with the target group and give the possibility to produce new themes and teaching materials.</p>

Description	<p>During the last decade narrative theory has proven still more valuable to various disciplines in the humanities (religion, history, sociology) as well as outside the humanities (cognitive theory, theory of organizations, branding, storytelling). The intensive programme in narratology (IPIN) aims at taking the teaching of narratives and narrative theory in Europe to the highest possible level by bringing together participants in the leading centres of narrative study in Europe.</p> <p>The programme targets European students, both Masters and advanced bachelors, who are working with narratives in written texts (fiction or non-fiction), in film, in computer games, in organizations or in marketing.</p> <p>The main activity of the programme is a two weeks course where the latest theoretical developments in narratology will be discussed and challenged. The programme will run for three years, with different themes each year. The theme of 2009 is "Narrating the Extreme", taking as its point of departure the fact that contemporary narratives dealing with extremes are abundant (traumas, testimonies, narratives on the boundaries of fiction and non-fiction, narratives from cultural margins).</p> <p>The main expected outputs of the programme are ECTS-points for the students and the gathering of valuable and needed knowledge on the intersections between narratives, narrative theory and didactics.</p>
