- Learning about the physical and psychological working environment and its influence on everyday activities in a workplace.
- Using electronic communication and information collection at a basic level in connection with the performance of work assignments.
- Making simple calculations of surface areas and volumes.
- Working on the basis of simple work drawings and using different scales.
- Learning how to use 'Standards and guidelines for landscape gardening' and 'Care of green areas'.
- Learning about plant protection and care and passing Landscape Gardening Tests 1 and 4 in order to obtain a plant spraying certificate in accordance with the rules set out by the Danish Ministry of Environment.
- Participating in waste sorting and resource optimisation in practical work.
- Learning about the basic properties of soil and various cultivation media, including the relationships between plant growth, cultivation methods and chemical, physical and biological soil conditions.
- Taking appropriate action and displaying responsibility as well as awareness of environmental and quality-related matters in connection with practical work assignments in the fields covered by the training programme on the basis of general biological, environmental and ecological insight.
- Identifying the plant species most commonly used in the trade and stating how they are used in connection with ordinary landscape gardening jobs.
- Performing basic soil treatment before and after the establishment of specific cultures, establishing a specific plant culture and handling basic care and maintenance of it.
- Using small landscape gardening machines and tools in a safe and ergonomically correct way.
- Carrying out simple hard surfacing jobs and making small stairs and retaining walls from various concrete materials.

- Sketching, planning and making necessary calculations of materials required in collaboration with others and establishing small areas with plants, flower beds, grass areas, including preparing the soil and performing finishing work before hand-over.
- Handling care and maintenance of soil and green areas in a way that is environmentally sound and in accordance with health and safety standards, and preparing simple care and upkeep programmes in collaboration with others.
- Identifying and naming ordinary plants, trees, bushes, herbaceous perennials, summer flowers, bulbs and tubers in their summer and winter states and making an appropriate selection of plants for a specific garden landscape.
- Carrying out work relating to plant protection in accordance with relevant health and safety standards, having passed Landscape Gardening Tests 2 and 3 to obtain a plant spraying certificate in compliance with the rules set out by the Danish Ministry of Environment.
- Using own knowledge of the connection between plant growth and chemical, physical and biological soil conditions.
- Using biological means to prevent pests in gardens, parks and other green areas in accordance with applicable environmental regulations and health and safety standards.
- Helping design and lay hard concrete surfacing, including jobs in which interlocking paving stones with end and edge stones are used, and adapting such paving.
- Designing and building stairs composed of concrete elements or paving stones, and working together with others in designing and constructing basins in flagstone paving.
- Carrying out all practical activities in connecting with measuring and levelling, and using different types of setting-off tools in connection with the setting off and establishment of small grounds and gardens.
- Using basic knowledge of the connection between cultural history and various garden styles and changes.
- Identifying plants from the most important plant groups and explaining requirements concerning growth conditions and care.
- Building wood structures in gardens, including fences, terraces, pergolas and paving.
- Performing the practical work assignments connected with chemical weed control and ecological care in an environmentally sound way and in accordance with health and safety standards.
- Analysing, recording, drawing and executing garden and park projects in accordance with applicable standards for landscape gardening, evaluating the quality of finished projects, fertilising new and old gardens and green areas and carrying out care and maintenance work in such areas.
- Selecting and assessing cultivation media on the basis of planting conditions in order to optimise plant growth.
