- Carrying out production assignments, drawing simple elements and making simple cost calculations concerning items typically used in maritime craft, on the basis of knowledge of the structure of vessels and their typical equipment, including technical installations.
- Making simple items (of wood and plastic) for ships, sails and tarpaulins, using the typical tools and machinery of the trade.
- Performing simple rope and wire splicing using basic knowledge of rigging and rigging types.
- Making drawings and specifying exact dimensions using basic knowledge of structural concepts relating to vessels.
- Performing various types of joining jobs such as lashing and gluing.
- Carrying out simple maritime building assignments on the basis of knowledge of concepts such as volume, displacement, buoyancy centre, centre of gravity, lateral centre, sail surface and centre, stability and metacentre.
